Summer camp in Moss, Norway, in 2020

Theme: «Nature, Art and Culture»

- Date:** 22 June – 3 July 2020
- Participants/age:** 16 – 18 years, preferably 6 girls and 6 boys, one from each country
- Arrival/departure:** The participants will be met by rotarians at Oslo airport (OSL or TRF, approx. 1.5 hours by car).
- Location:** Jeløy is an island and part of Moss town, located approx. 60 km south of Oslo on the Eastern bank of the Oslo fjord.
- Programme:** Jeløy Rotary Club has prepared a varied programme with theme-related activities in and around Moss. Our main focus is FRIENDSHIP. We hope to give you a taste of Norwegian food and lifestyle, art (e.g. the painter Edvard Munch), recreational life (hiking and canoeing) and seaside activities (swimming and boating). During the first week, an overnight stay will be arranged so that everyone can get to know each other better.
- We also plan a day trip to Norway's capital, Oslo, where we will visit landmark sights, including the Holmenkollen ski jump, Vigeland sculpture park, Oslo opera house.
- Costs:** A fee of EUR 100 will be payable upon arrival. Flight tickets, pocket money and insurance must be paid by the participants.
- Language:** English (oral skills as well as understanding)
- Accommodation:** Private host families. Standard Norwegian/European food.
- Insurance:** Participants must be insured against illness, accidents and third party liability according to Rotary International recommendations. No insurance is provided by the camp.
- Application:** Application forms can be downloaded from your national Rotary association's website. Please fill in your personal data and have your local Rotary club and District Youth Exchange Officer (DYEO) sign it.

Procedure: When the 12 participants have been selected, they will receive more information in due course
