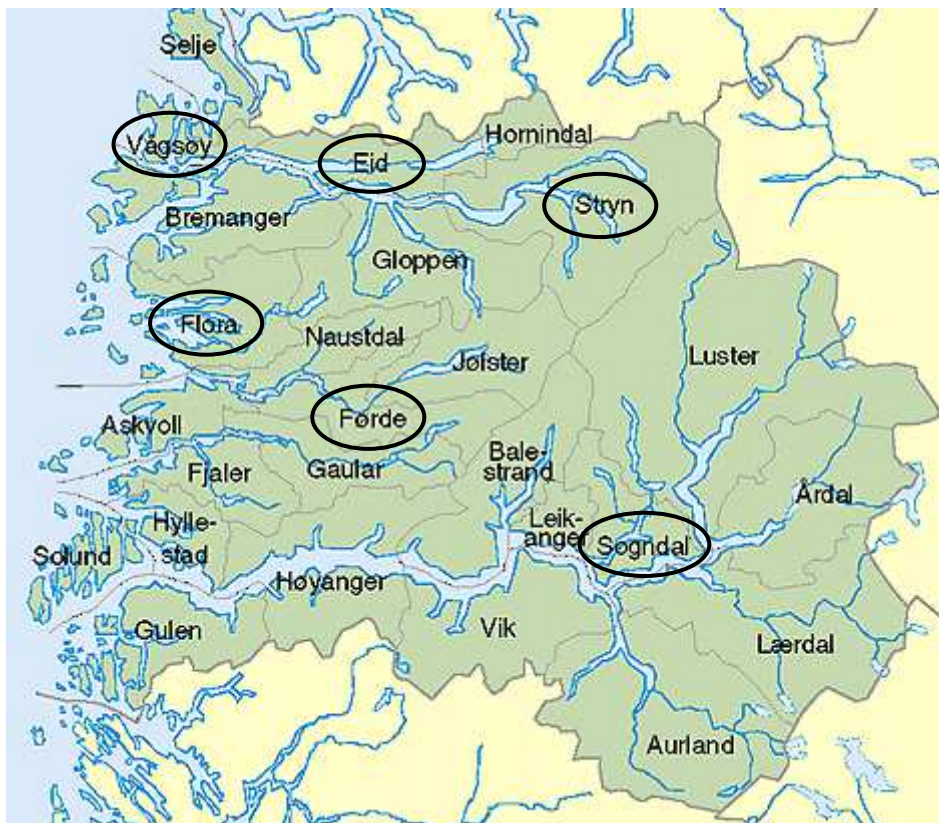




Summer Camp: Explore The Fjords - August 2020! The Rotary Clubs of **District 2250**, Northern area. We invite 10 young people from all over the world, age 16-18 years, to take part in a Round Trip in some of the most renowned areas of Norway. And of course, in addition to scenery and history, this is an opportunity to make new friends from other countries and continents.



In the Western part you'll find the famous fjords, the mountains and the glacier Jostedalbreen, quite a number of historic sites, and indeed great sceneries. Each club will take well care of you in every way, and they will also have prepared a program for you, and these programs will in total give you a good idea as to what this western part of the country is all about.

The tour is taking place in the period of **August 8th to August 21st. 2020**. We invite 10 young people, age 16-18. Arrival in Bergen on Saturday the 8th of August where Rotary members meet you at Bergen Airport Flesland.

The next day you'll travel by boat to **Måløy** (Vågsøy) from Bergen at 16:30hrs. In Måløy you will be met by members from Nordfjordeid Rotary Club. Your stay in **Eid** will be from Sunday 9th to Tuesday the 11th of August.



You will later go on to **Stryn** 11th to 13th, **Sogndal** 13th to 15th, **Førde** 15th to 17th and then **Florø** 17th to 19th.



Finally you'll be back in **Bergen** where you stay from the 19th to the 21st, then it will be time to and leave. You will leave Norway from Bergen Airport Flesland.

Cost:

A fee of 150 Euros will be required upon arrival. Travel expenses to Norway, pocket money and insurance must be paid by the participants.

Accommodation:

Mostly in private homes, but also in hostels some nights.

Insurance:

The participants must be insured against illness, accidents and third party damages. No insurance is provided by the camp

Language and food: English language and standard European/ Norwegian food

Application:

Obtain the application form at your national Rotarys home page. Fill in your personal data and obtain signatures from your local Rotary Club and District Youth Exchange Officer (DYEO). The DYEO should send the application (in PDF format) to Vivianne Jodalen, national STEP coordinator Norway, before the 31st of March

Procedure:

10 people will be selected for participation, and they will receive an acceptance letter including more information.
