Flekkefjord Rotary Club 20 – 24 June

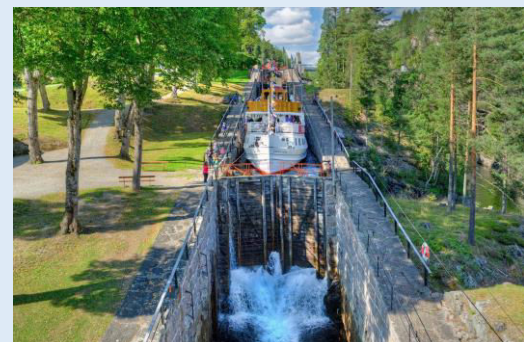
